

MINUTES
ACWSA WI/IL REGIONAL BOARD MEETING
October 11, 2020

3. Paymaster Report – Darlene reported that the bank balance is currently \$3201.84, right on budget.

4. The 2021 Skirmish Schedule was approved, all ACWSA/N-SSA Friendship Shoots:

April 23-25, 2nd WI skirmish near Springfield, IL
June 5-6, 66th NC skirmish near Appleton,
June 26-27, Battery H skirmish near Streator, IL
July 17-18, 56 VA skirmish in Bristol, WI
August 15-16 or 21-22, 46IL skirmish in Beloit, WI
September 3-5, 8WI skirmish near Rhinelander, WI
September 18-19, 15 WI skirmish in Bristol, WI

There will be no Boscobel skirmish next year. The 46th IL skirmish will be close to, but not on that date. N-SSA Board meetings are on the last weekend of January and first weekend of August and no N-SSA shoots are allowed on those weekends.

5. Covid-19 protocol at skirmishes – all agreed to wait until the start of the next season to discuss.

6. Avoid Smoothbore pistol team matches at joint skirmishes – Currently N-SSA members cannot participate in, or even be on the field during ACWSA Smoothbore Pistol Team matches. The N-SSA currently allows Individual Smoothbore Pistol competition but has a moratorium on team competitions until they have new rules. Their current proposals require

tables and loading stands. The latest conversations on the N-SSA Bulletin Board says SB pistol was originally intended for individual competition only – not team competitions.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 12:06 p.m.
