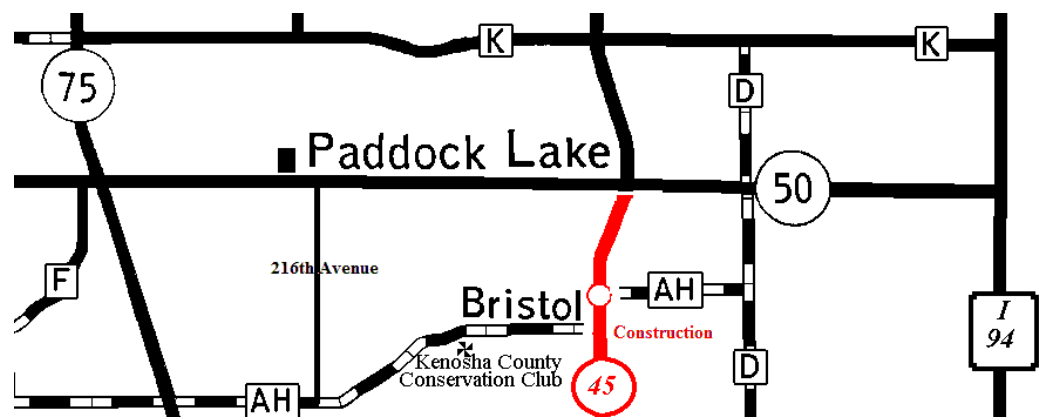

Smoothbore Musket

- 25 yd. Pigeon Board (X3/Person)
- 25 yd. 4" Ceramic Tiles (X2/Person)
- 50 yd. Gal. Jugs (x3/Team)

Carbine/ Musket team

- 50 yd. Pigeon Board (x4 Person)
- 50 yd. 4" Ceramic Tiles (X2/Person)
- 50 yd. Hang. Pigeons (X2/Person)
- 50 yd. Junque Event (X10/Team)
- 50 yd. 16" Dry Wall 2 Minute Rapid Fire

Breechloader (targeting doubled for Repeaters).
