The **19th Michigan Volunteer Infantry** cordially invites units of the Northwest Territory (NWT) and the American Civil War Shooting Association (ACWSA) to attend the first Northwest Territory Regional Skirmish of 2018, scheduled for 15-17 June at the Lansing Muzzle Loading Gun Club in Laingsburg, MI.

Team fees for NWT units are waived for the skirmish. Units outside the NWT must pay the entry fee. ***ALL UNITS entering teams are required to submit the Team Registration form so that the host unit can plan accordingly.***

Camping opens at 12 noon on Friday, June 15. Approximately 20 hook-ups are available for electricity, but they aren't adequate to run AC. A \$10 fee will be collected per hook-up. Ground fires will be allowed unless extremely dry conditions present a safety hazard. *Please fill in fire pits following the skirmish.* Skirmishers are asked to bring their own water and take trash home for disposal. A dumpster is on site, but that is reserved for broken targets and other waste from the range.

Once again, the Lansing Muzzle Loading Gun Club will be providing food service for the weekend, **servicing both breakfast and lunch on Saturday and Sunday**. No evening meals provided.

All N-SSA rules will be in effect throughout the skirmish weekend. Individual events will be classified per NWT classifications, with places paid accordingly.

In an effort to be more "earth friendly," please return un-hit targets to the containers located by the NWT trailer. Also, remain vigilant and pick up any wires in the ready area or on the shooting range that can cause mower damage.

SCHEDULE OF ACTIVITIES

FRIDAY, JUNE 15

- 1230 hours Individual targeting available for purchase
- 1300-1600 Range opens for individuals. All targets are 5 shots. Relays will be 15 minutes in duration. First target purchased for each event will be \$2. Re-entry targets are \$1 each. Aggregate matches are \$1 and must be paid and declared with the first entry. Protest fee is \$5, to be paid at time of protest. No protests accepted after 18:00 Saturday, June 16, for individual targets.

SATURDAY, JUNE 16

- 0830 hours Individual targeting available for purchase
- 0900-1300 Range opens for individuals. All targets are 5 shots. Relays will be 15 minutes in duration. First target purchased for each event will be \$2. Re-entry targets are \$1 each. Aggregate matches are \$1 and must be paid and declared with the first entry. Protest fee is \$5, to be paid at time of protest. No protests accepted after 18:00 Saturday, June 16, for individual targets.
- 1315 hours Commanders meeting for carbine and smoothbore team competition, held at the base of the tower. Attendance is mandatory for each team.
- 1330 hours **Carbine team competition** (5 person teams)
20 clay pigeons on a backer (50 yards)
10 4"x 4" hanging ceramic tiles (50 yards)
10 hanging clay pigeons (50 yards)
10 hanging water filled latex gloves (50 yards)
7 6" x 6" hanging ceramic tiles (100 yards)

Smoothbore team competition will start as soon as all teams are ready following completion of the carbine match.

- 1600 hours or before **Smoothbore team competition** (3 person teams)
9 clay pigeons on a backer (25 yds)
6 3"x 6" hanging ceramic tiles (25 yds)
6 hanging clay pigeons (25 yds)
1 12" x 12" hanging drywall (50 yds, rapid fire)

SUNDAY, JUNE 17

- 0900 hours Musket team commanders meeting at the tower
- 0915 hours Opening ceremonies
- 0930 hours **Musket team competition** (5 person teams)
- 20 clay pigeons on a backer (50 yards)
 - 10 4" x 4" hanging ceramic tiles (50 yards)
 - 10 hanging clay pigeons (50 yards)
 - 10 hanging water filled latex gloves (50 yards)
 - 7 6" x 6" hanging tiles (100 yards)
 - 2 12" x 12" hanging drywall (100 yards, rapid fire)

Awards ceremony will be held as soon as possible after the musket match.

DIRECTIONS TO LANSING MUZZLELOADING GUN CLUB LAINGSBURG, MICHIGAN

NOTE:

For those wanting to program a route using GPS, the physical address of the LMLGC is 8545 Garrison Road, Laingsburg, MI.

FROM THE DETROIT AREA...

Take I-96 west to M-52 north toward Owosso. Approximately 7 miles north of Perry, turn left (west) on Bennington Road. Take Bennington approximately 5-1/2 miles to Leland Road. Go south on Leland for about 2/3 mile. Just as Leland sweeps to the right, take a hard left on Garrison Road (gravel road). The entrance to the gun club is about 1/8 mile on the right.

FROM THE FLINT AREA...

Take I-69 south to Exit 105 (Perry). From Perry, head north on M-52 toward Owosso. Approximately 7 miles north of Perry, turn left (west) on Bennington Road. Take Bennington approximately 5-1/2 miles to Leland Road. Go south on Leland for about 2/3 mile. Just as Leland sweeps to the right, take a hard left on Garrison Road (gravel road). The entrance to the gun club is about 1/8 mile on the right.

FROM THE NORTH...

Take Route 27 south, past St. Johns to Price Road. Follow Price Road east toward Sleepy Hollow State Park. At the county line, Price Road becomes Garrison Road and turns to gravel. When the gravel road ends, continue east for approximately 1/8 mile on Leland Road (paved road). Just as Leland starts to sweep to the left, go straight on the gravel road (which is Garrison Road once again). The entrance to the gun club is about 1/8 mile on the right.

FROM THE WEST...

Take I-96 east to I-69 north to Exit 98 (Laingsburg). Head north on Woodbury Road for approximately 1-1/2 miles until you come to the intersection of Bath Road. Turn right on Bath, go about 1/8 mile and turn left on Woodbury Road again. Follow Woodbury approximately 4-1/2 miles until you come to a 4-way stop. Go straight through the 4-way stop and continue for about 1/2 mile until Woodbury ends. Turn right and then immediately left on Leland Road, following it north. Leland will make a big sweeping curve to the right and then a big sweeping curve to the left. Just as Leland sweeps left, go straight on Garrison Road (gravel road). The entrance to the gun club is about 1/8 mile on the right.

FROM THE SOUTHWEST...

Take I-69 north to Exit 98 (Laingsburg). Head north on Woodbury Road for approximately 1-1/2 miles until you come to the intersection of Bath Road. Turn right on Bath, go approximately 1/8 mile and turn left on Woodbury Road again. Follow Woodbury approximately 4-1/2 miles until you come to a 4-way stop. Go straight through the 4-way stop and continue for about 1/2 mile until Woodbury ends. Turn right and then immediately left on Leland Road, following it north. Leland will make a big sweeping curve to the right and then a big sweeping curve to the left. Just as Leland sweeps left, go straight on Garrison Road (gravel road). The entrance to the gun club is about 1/8 mile on the right.

FROM THE SOUTH...

Take Hwy 127 north toward Jackson. Northeast of Jackson, Hwy 127 runs concurrent with I-94 for approximately 4 miles. Follow 127/I-94 until it becomes Hwy 127 north again. Take 127 north to I-69 north to Exit 98 (Laingsburg). Head north on Woodbury Road for approximately 1-1/2 miles until you come to the intersection of Bath Road. Turn right on Bath, go approximately 1/8 mile and turn left on Woodbury Road again. Follow Woodbury approximately 4-1/2 miles until you come to a 4-way stop. Go straight through the 4-way stop and continue for about 1/2 mile until Woodbury ends. Turn right and then immediately left on Leland Road, following it north. Leland will make a big sweeping curve to the right and then a big sweeping curve to the left. Just as Leland sweeps left, go straight on Garrison Road (gravel road).
