WE WILL BE SPACING OUT THE FIRING LINE AND READY AREA TO GIVE EVERYONE PLENTY OF ROOM. WHEN PARKING YOUR VEHICLE MAINTAIN ENOUGH SPACING SO AS TO COMPLY WITH SOCIAL DISTANCING. WE NEED YOUR COOPERATION TO MAKE THIS WORK.

SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

SUNDAY:

0845 : Registration for Musket teams opens

0915: Registration for musket Closes

0930: Musket team commander meeting

0945: opening ceremony

1000: Musket Team match—4-6 person teams. All events are 50 yards

1. 24 clays on a backer
2. 12 hanging metal clovers plus one hanging clay to be shot first
3. 12 hanging metal stars plus one hanging clay to be shot first
4. 12 hanging 4-inch ceramic tiles plus one hanging clay to be shot first

5. 12 hanging clay pigeons

Above targeting is based on 6 person team—2-4 targets/shooter

All units are responsible for cleaning up their frame and ready areas. Assistance with clean-up of range equipment will be greatly appreciated.

There will be an artillery match following the conclusion of the musket match.

In addition—on Saturday September 19, 2020 there is a WW2 match in the morning. A possible mortar match for Saturday afternoon.
