

# ACWSA Richmond Skirmish Richmond Sportsman's Club August 7,8,9, 2020

The 1<sup>st</sup> Michigan Infantry and 1<sup>st</sup> South Carolina Vol. Inf. invite all ACWSA units to attend the ACWSA skirmish on August 7-9th at the Richmond Sportsman's Club (9134 Big Hand Road, Columbus, MI). There will be free camping for anyone who wishes to stay for the weekend. Camping will open on Friday, August 7 at noon. Maintain a 20-foot spacing on campsites. You will need to take your trash home as there is very limited space which is reserved for target debris. Food service will not be available on Saturday and Sunday for lunch Bring your own food please. Bottled water and bottled Gatorade will be available. All ACWSA rules will apply and matches are paid for as teams are registered for matches at the skirmish.

WE HAVE TO MAINTAIN SOCIAL DISTANCING, so we strongly suggest that your unit brings more than one canopy for the ready area. We will be spacing out the firing line and ready area to give everyone plenty of room. When parking your vehicle maintain enough spacing so as to comply with social distancing. We need your cooperation to make this work.

#### SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

<u>FRIDAY, August 7:</u> Camping area opens at noon. <u>Maintain a 20-foot spacing on campsites.</u> The range is not open for shooting. You are invited to help with range setup.

## **SATURDAY, August 8:**

8:30AM: Registration for all Saturday team events opens. All teams will be limited to no more than the maximum number allowed in order to maintain social distancing on the line.

Mortar crew setup (\$15 per mortar)

9:00 AM - Mortar Match w/ 100-yard stake to be provided by each crew, 7 shot max; 5 closest to stake for score. This is a forty-five-minute match.

Due to the amount of space needed to run the revolver match the revolver match has been canceled. The range will not be open for small arms practice.

**10:30 AM - Carbine Match** (4 person teams, \$5.00 per person) – 2 relays, 5-minute events

- 1. 50 yds: 16 clays on a backer
- 2. 50 yds: 8 hanging metal clovers plus one hanging clay to be shot first.
- 3. 50 yds: 8 hanging metal stars and 1 water bottle (bring your own dye)
- 4. 50 yds: 8 hanging 4-inch ceramic tiles plus one hanging clay to be shot first.
- 5. 50 yds: 8 hanging clays plus one hanging tile to be shot first.

**1:30 PM - Smoothbore Team Match** (3 person teams, \$5.00 per person) – 1 relay, 3-minute events. *Each team needs to supply one timer/safety.* 

- 1. 50 yds: 5 water-filled gallon jugs (bring your own dye)
- 2. 25 yds: 9 clays on a backer
- 3. 25 yds: 6 hanging clay pigeons
- 4. 25 yds: 6 hanging 4" ceramic tiles

- 4. 50 yds: 12 hanging 4-inch ceramic tiles plus one hanging clay to be shot first
- 5. 50 yds: 12 hanging clay pigeons
