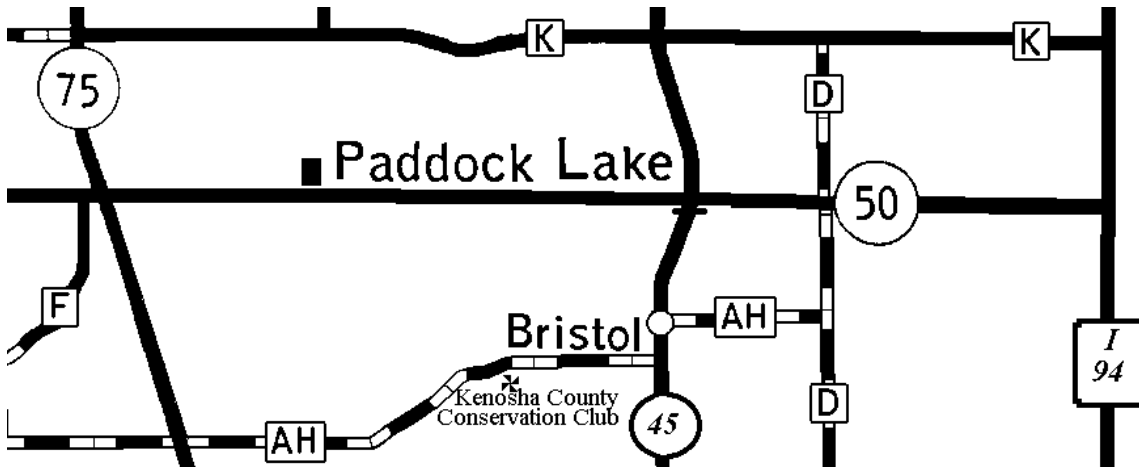

First through third for team Breech Loader, Smoothbore, Carbine and Rifled Musket

Notes:

Uniforms must be worn for all team events unless weather dictates otherwise.

Revolvers shooters may use two hands.

Revolvers can only be capped on line.

All times subject to change.

Timers may inform the team of how much time is remaining during an event, but only if asked to do so. Stay safe and shoot well.

Commanders: Please have your teams ready when called to the line. Individuals forgetting ramrods, caps, ammo, still cleaning guns etc. are disrespectful to everybody standing on the line waiting for them! Timers must report team time (in seconds) and targets remaining to the desk as soon as practicable. In team events, after the Safety checks each individual gun he clears his team (unless there is a fouled musket, etc.) all at one time by saying “the line is cleared”. For the sake of time, please appoint your safeties and timers before each event.
