NWT members (who are not ACWSA members) will pay a \$15 insurance fee and \$5 shoot fee per person.**

SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

SATURDAY, September 23 : 8:00 AM Range setup

8:15 AM: Registration for all Saturday team events opens. All teams will be limited to no more than the maximum number allowed. WE WILL HAVE TWO RELAYS.

9:00 AM: Registration for Musket Team closed

9:15 AM: Musket Team commander's meeting at the base of the tower

9:30 AM: Opening Ceremony

9:45 AM: Musket Team match. (5 person teams) – 2 relays, 5-minute events

1. 50 yds: 20 clays on a backer
2. 50 yds: 10 hanging Ceramic tiles plus one hanging target (clay bird) to be shot first
3. 50 yds: 10 hanging metal stars
4. 50 yds: 10 hanging 4-inch metal acorns plus one hanging target (water bottle) to be shot first (Rolling Thunder)

12:00: Carbine Team registration closed

12:00 (or sooner) : Lunch break 30 minutes

12:30 PM (or sooner): Carbine Team Commanders' meeting.

12:45 PM - Carbine Match (4 person teams) – 2 relays, 5-minute events

1. 50 yds: 16 clays on a backer
2. 50 yds: 8 hanging ceramic tiles plus one hanging target (clay bird) to be shot first.
3. 50 yds: 8 hanging metal stars
4. 50 yds: 8 hanging 4-inch metal acorns plus one hanging target (water bottle) to be shot first (Rolling Thunder)

2:30 PM - Registration for Smoothbore Team closed

2:45 PM - Smoothbore Team Commander's meeting

3:00 PM - Smoothbore Team Match (3 person teams) – 1 relay, 3-minute events.

Each team needs to supply one timer/safety.

1. 25 yds: 9 clays on a backer
2. 25 yds: 6 hanging clay pigeons
3. 25 yds: 6 hanging 4" ceramic tiles
