I CERTIFY ON HONOR, that I have carefully examined the above named Volunteer, agreeably to the General Regulations of the Army, and that in my opinion he is free from all bodily defect and mental infirmity, which would in any way disqualify him from performing the duties of a soldier.

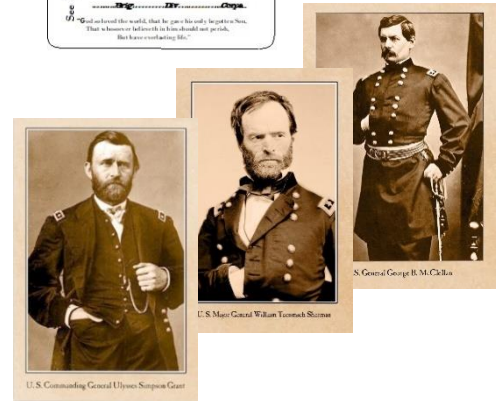
