The sport of Skirmishing combines Civil War era weapons with marksmanship competitions. It's a fast paced hobby that's both fun and educational.

The ACWSA a wide range of individual and team competitions. Members can participate in all, or concentrate on only the ones they choose.



Skirmishers join together into teams representing specific regiments that participated in the Civil War.



Our marksmanship competitions, called skirmishes, are open to both men and women. Competitors dress in authentic civil war era uniforms and clothing, and shoot either original or replica firearms.

## A typical skirmish includes:

**Individual Competition**, using muskets, carbines, revolvers, breech loaders, smoothbore muskets and pistols, shooting at paper bulls-eye targets at ranges from 25 to 100 yards.

**Team Competition**, using muskets, carbines, revolvers, breech loaders, smoothbore muskets and pistols, and sometimes mortars. Teams are judged for both speed and accuracy.

At the end of competitions, awards are presented to the top individuals and teams in each category.
